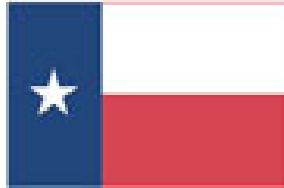

On June 3, 2006, Leslie Recine and Jim Borchert were chosen by the delegates of Senate District 10, to be your representatives to the State Republican Executive Committee (SREC) for the next two years. Between State conventions, one man and one woman from each of the State's 31 senatorial districts sit on a committee of 64 to deliberate and decide upon the business of the Republican Party of Texas (RPT).

We are your servants, serving the grassroots of our senatorial district, to carry your civil and political interests to the State and to bring back pertinent information from the State Party, and from your State Senator (the Honorable Kim Brimer) and State Representatives. All political sovereignty resides in the people, in their aggregate capacity, by the will and pleasure of the Almighty.
